### FROM THE PRINCIPALS DESK

(Part 6 of my synopsis of 12 Huge Mistakes Parents Can Avoid - Leading Your Kids to Succeed in Life by Dr. Tim Elmore)

Mistake #5: We remove the consequences. When we insulate kids and remove consequences from actions, we fail to prepare them for the future that awaits them. Why do we remove consequence? We don't want them to suffer. We want to prevent any disadvantages. It's easier. We want them to have great self-esteem. We want to get them to love us. We want to be in control. But we need to decide - is this about now or later? The biggest adjustment we must make is to stop pursuing control. To learn to trust and to empower our kids to navigate their way through life without the misconception that they can control it. *Adaptability* should be our aim. The problem is, we often live, lead, and parent only for today. We just want peace right now and we forget the long-term impact on our kids. When I was a child, consequences came even if it were a little white lie. My parents knew I was forming long-term patterns in my life every day. So, what can we do?

- Let them struggle, and if they fail, interpret the experience with them. Don't rescue them, but if they fall or fail, talk it over. Show them it's not the end of the world it's a chance to try again!
- Tell them stories about your own struggles and failures. Talk about your past flops, failures, and fumbles. Show them how those made you into the person you are today.
- Don't expect teacher to be nannies to your child. As you interact with your child's teachers, don't ask them to be a second mom or dad. They are a good precursor to a boss at work.
- Help them put their finger on something they really want to achieve. Goals are important. They are targets to shoot for, and they are either hit or miss.
- Establish rewards that require hard work and progress. Separate the idea of merely showing up from putting out effort. Set a reward they can receive only if they really excel.
- Discuss your ambitions and how you felt when you accomplished them. Talk
  about an ambition you had years ago, how you felt when you pursued it, and how
  rewarding it was inside to earn it.
- Communicate your love and belief in them regardless of what happens. Love should not be a reward for performing. Caring adults must demonstrate belief regardless of accomplishments.
- Stop making excuses. When they make a mistake, help them to own it. Don't teach them to blame others or make excuses. They must eventually learn that life isn't fair.

The further out you look, the better parenting decision you'll make. Short-term benefits often bring long-term consequences. Short-term consequences often bring long-term benefits.
