#### Reading Tips for Parents of Emerging Readers

Give your child lots of opportunities to read aloud. Inspire your young reader to practice every day! The tips below offer some fun ways you can help your child become a happy and confident reader. Try a new tip each week. See what works best for your child.

- Don't leave home without it. Bring along a book or magazine any time your child has to wait.
- Once is not enough. Encourage kids to re-read a favorite book or poem.
- Dig deeper into the story. Ask your child questions about the story you've just read.
- *Take control of the television*. It's difficult for reading to compete with TV. Encourage reading as a free-time activity.
- I read to you, you read to me. Take turns reading aloud at bedtime.
- Talk, talk talk! Talk with your child every day about school and things going on around the house. Sprinkle interesting and new works into the conversation.
- Write, write, write! Ask your child to help you write out the grocery list, a thank you note, or keep a journal. When writing, encourage your child to use the letter and sound patterns he is learning at school.
