## FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

<u>Time With Dad</u> (from Focus on the Family)

Spending one-on-one time with each child is one of the best things you can do as a father. Your kids will look forward to your time together. It might take some time, but here are some tips to make this work for your family.


Before your time together - Give your children different options, allowing them to pick from activities that fit your time, schedule, and finances. When money is tight, they can choose from no-cost and low-cost things (e.g. parks, hikes, or going for ice cream). When you can afford it, choose an event that fits your children's interests, like a sports game or dinner out.

During an activity - On your "date", try to keep the conversation focused on topics that relate to the individual child. This dedicated conversation time will give you a deeper connection with each child.

After your time - On the days that follow your activity, bring up things you talked about and memories that were made. Asking questions like "what was your favorite part?" helps you both savor the memory. ~Mrs. Perez






