FROM THE PRINCIPALS DESK

Teaching Kids About LENT

During my childhood, growing up in a Lutheran church meant that Lent was about giving up candy or sweets for a few weeks. I was taught that Lent is preparation for Jesus' death and resurrection, but it wasn't something I necessarily looked forward to. Lent didn't have the outward beauty of Advent, with its evergreen wreath, Christmas hymns and weekly candle lighting. It was somber. It was almost too reflective for a kid. What is Lent all about, anyway? How do we teach our kids it's more than just giving up candy for 40 days?

As I explored the deeper meaning of Lent, I discovered how very important this season can be in preparation to celebrate the joy of the Resurrection! As with any BIG event in our lives, we must prepare ourselves. Lent is literally a time of reflection on the the passion of Jesus; 40 days in which we reflect on the hugeness of what our Salvation is and the plan that God had for each of us through Jesus.

Lent starts on Ash Wednesday (Feb. 14 this year) and ends during Holy Week. During the 40 days of Lent, Christians remember the time when Jesus went into the desert to fast and pray before beginning his work for God. For Christians, we might choose to remember this by choosing to fast ourselves. Your family might give up meat on Fridays or choose to give up sweets. Another way to instruct your children to "fast" during their Lenten journey is by encouraging them to be more loving to siblings and parents. Fasting from arguing with siblings or talking back to parents for 40 days will lead to good practices that might even last past Easter Sunday! — Mrs. Perez






