

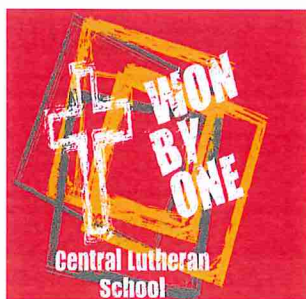

FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Finding Easter in Bunnies and Baskets <https://bit.ly/2E3g0cu>

If you have walked through store aisles lately, you've seen many reminders that Easter is coming. What isn't so obvious is that, for Christians, Easter is truly the most significant day of the year.

At the store we find:

- baskets and eggs as the symbols of Easter, instead of a cross and an empty tomb
- a bunny that brings candy instead of a Savior who brings life

~Tell the Story of Easter with Eggs

Instead of merely coloring eggs this Easter, why not use the eggs to tell the story of God's love and forgiveness? Before you hide the eggs or put them in baskets, encircle each one with a colored strip of paper (or place the strip inside plastic eggs) that tells one small part of the Easter story. When the eggs have been found, the children must unscramble the story and put it in the right order.

~Teach them about Jesus by talking about what a real Easter Bunny is

Use a rabbit picture or a stuffed bunny to teach some of the characteristics of Jesus that we should all try to have. By adding a Bible verse to each quality, you will create a true Easter Bunny.

Real Easter bunnies:

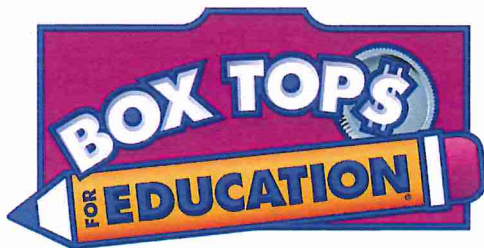
- are white as snow because Jesus takes all sin away (Is 1:18b).
- are gentle, kind-hearted and forgiving (Eph 4:32).
- have big ears that are quick to listen (Jam 1:19).
- have big eyes to look carefully and choose what is good (1 Thess 5:21).
- have big feet to go tell others about Jesus so they can be like Easter bunnies, too (Matt 28: 19-20).
- eat what is healthy by filling up on God's word every day (Ps 119:11).

Central Lutheran School, Newhall is looking to fill the position of Paraprofessional Aide for the preschool room for the 18-19 school year. Work days are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, 7:45am-3:45pm. Pay is hourly.

Requirements: a 2 or 4 year degree or a paraprofessional license from the state of Iowa.

A paraprofessional assists the classroom teacher with instructional and non-instructional duties. Although actual duties can be varied, some tasks include: prepare materials, enforce school rules, perform clerical duties, supervise students in and out of the classroom, keep classroom neat and in order, observe student's performance/progress, change diapers, and assist students by providing general guidance.
