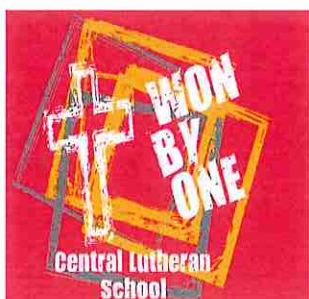

I just can't imagine a world without you.*

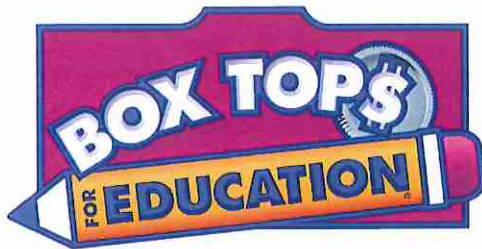

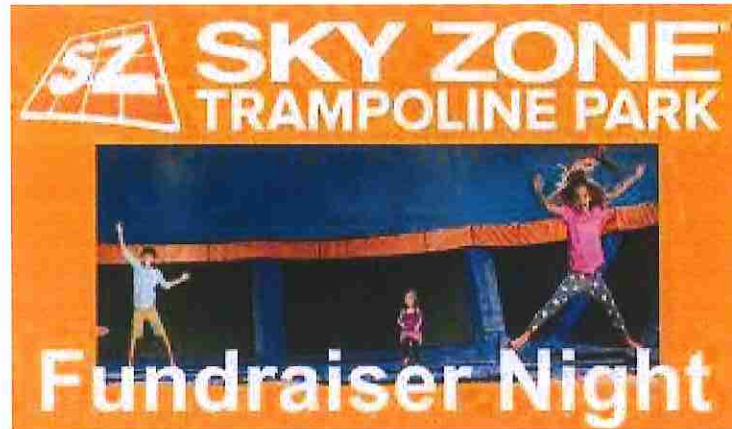

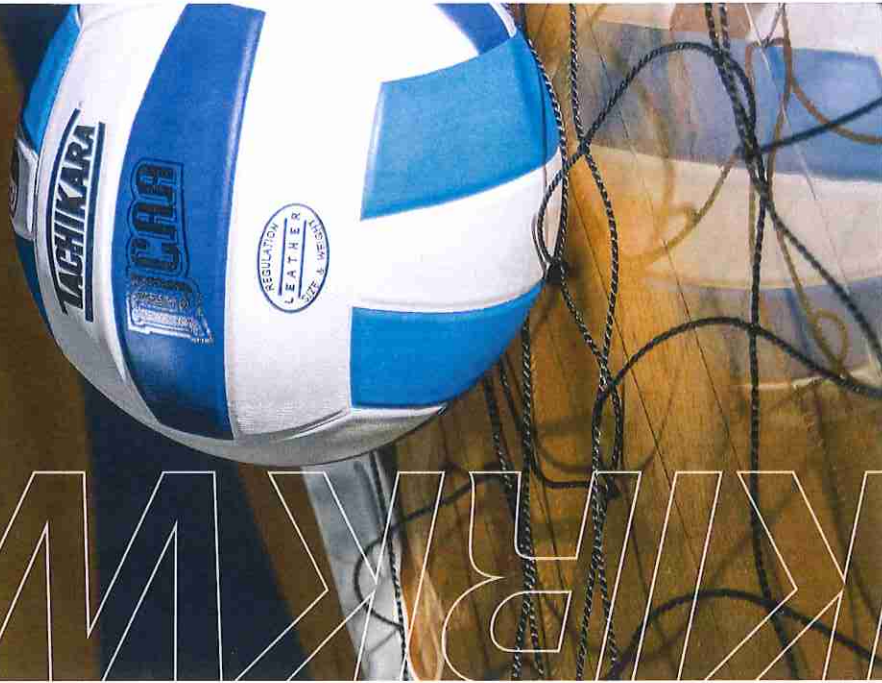
