Frankly Speaking - From the CLS Principal's Desk

How are things going?

I wish I had the opportunity to ask each parent how things are going. I have had the chance to meet with a few parents either in the hallway or in my office and ask that question. I know we are only about 10 days into the new school year, but a routine should be set by now with a place to do homework in the house, a specific time to do homework, a specific bedtime each night, a specific time to get up in the morning and then the routine that follows from that. I have talked to the teachers and some teachers are noticing different things about certain students and ways to help them. I've encouraged the teachers to keep parents up to date on how students are doing, and not wait until parent/teacher conferences. So, try to take a bit of time and ask the teachers how things are going whether in person or through email. This can be about, "how is my child doing?", or "what do you think about the new principal?" (wait, maybe don't ask that!!!) or on a personal level, "how are you doing?" With some new teachers on the staff, it makes new teachers feel welcome when parents ask how they are doing. No matter what the situation, we want to continue to keep the lines of communication open from parent to teacher, teacher to parent, and parent/teacher to principal. The school will run better and students will get the attention and care they need to grow into strong Christian leaders!

I haven't had any 4th grade parents contact me yet about leading our brunch fundraiser. Please check your emails for the message I sent out on Monday, Sep. 3 asking for your assistance.

God's blessings to you and your family! If there is anything I can do to help with your child's Christian education here, please give a call, email, or stop by to set up an appointment.



The primary purpose of the Fall 3 on 3 League and Skill Development sessions is to improve upon offensive basketball fundamentals with an emphasis on shooting, ball handling, passing, and motion basketball principles within a 3 on 3 setting. Each night will consist of 45 minutes of skill development work followed by 30 minutes of playing 3 on 3 games within each grade level. These sessions will also work to promote teamwork, communication, and building self-confidence for girls within each grade level.

These fall sessions will serve as a starting point for any Benton Girls Basketball Youth Teams that will be competing during the winter basketball season. Any parents/coaches that will be working with girls basketball players this winter are welcomed/encouraged to attend these sessions to help coach; as well as, to observe different offensive drills that can be implemented throughout the winter season within your teams to continue to improve basketball fundamentals. The goal of our girls basketball youth program is to establish a solid foundation for the continued success of the girls basketball program at Benton Community for many years to come!
