

#### Frankly Speaking - From the CLS Principal's Desk

Have you looked at the calendar?

Yep, it is that time of year...fall testing for your child at CLS. For the next two weeks your child will be tested during our fall testing schedule. These are very helpful to us as teachers and administration so we know 1) if our curriculum is doing what it should, 2) if our teachers are teaching the curriculum we have correctly or if we can find a better way to do it, 3) where your child is at so he/she can be helped more on his/her weaknesses and improve on his/her strengths.

The following are a few suggestions that come from the Department of Education on how you can help your child with his/her tests.

1)Talk to your child about the testing. Let them know why testing is taking place.

2) Tell your child what "standardized" tests are. These tests use the same standards to measure student performance across the state or even across the country. Every student takes the same test according to the same rules. This makes it possible to measure each student's performance against that of others.

3) Do provide a quiet, comfortable place for studying at home and make sure that your child is well rested on school days and especially on the day of a test. Children who are tired are less able to pay attention in class or to handle the demands of a test.

4) Do eat a breakfast with protein and low sugar. Too much sugar for breakfast will have a child "crash" halfway through the morning, thus losing focus on testing. A breakfast high in protein will allow your child to sustain a steady focus throughout the morning.

5) Do help your child avoid test anxiety. It's good for your child to be concerned about taking a test. It's not good for him/her to develop "test anxiety." Test anxiety is worrying too much about doing well on a test. It can mean disaster for your child. Students with test anxiety can worry about success in school and about their future success. They can become very self-critical and lose confidence in their abilities. Instead of feeling challenged by the prospect of success, they become afraid of failure. If your child worries too much about taking tests, you can help to reduce the anxiety by encouraging your child to do the following things.

When he/she gets the test, read the directions carefully before you begin work. If you don't understand how to do something, ask the teacher to explain. Look quickly at the entire text to see what types of questions are on it (multiple choice, matching, true/false, essay). See if different questions are worth different numbers of points. This will help you to determine how much time to spend on each part of the test. Finally, if your child doesn't know the answer to a question, skip it and go on. Don't waste time worrying about one question. Mark it and, if you have time at the end of the test, return to it and try again.

Thanks to our 4th grade parents for stepping up and have started working on our brunch for this year. I look forward to seeing how this works and the fun and fellowship of putting this together.




