



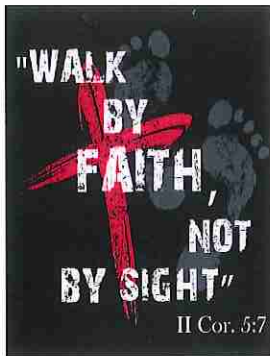

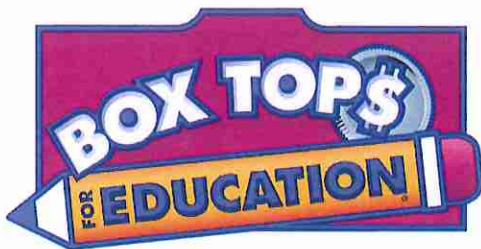

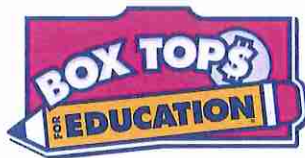

The treasurer's report was submitted for review by Abbie Rathje. Abbie discussed the expected expenditures through the rest of the school year and plant sales. A motion was made to accept the report by Ally Getka, second by Lana Robinson. Motion passed.

Committee Reports:

- Sarah Gorsh and Rachel McCloud discussed the Spring Fling. They will be putting their report together and distributing when it's ready. They increased from 1 face painter to 2 this year to help keep lines short. They also doubled the number of games than what was offered at the 2017 Spring Fling. They thought that maybe for the 2021 Spring Fling they might not go with the doubled amount but somewhere in between. They had a hard time finding enough workers for all the games.
- Lana Robinson discussed the staff Christmas party on behalf of SAC to possibly offer a gift card for the restaurant that the staff chooses to go to for the party. That way, if anyone can't attend the night of the staff party, they can still utilize the gift card for another time.
- Michelle Hines said she is going to be putting together a newsletter to send out to recruit current 3rd grade parents that could help with the fall brunch.

Old Business:

- Jessica Fry and Abbie Rathje discussed this year's plant sales. They used a new greenhouse (Proschaska Green House) and flowers looked great. The weather did not cooperate, and the plant sale was earlier in the year than past sales. Discussed about moving a week or two to get some warmer weather and more people.

New Business

- Financial Requests:
 - Mr. Ballantyne needs some percussion supplies. Needing at least two new mallets (\$75) Dave Runge made a motion to pay for the supplies. Second Lana Robinson. Motion passed.
 - A donation of band equipment flyer was discussed for Jackie to include in her newsletter.

- Lana Robinson will post on Central Families Helping Families Facebook page for people to see, and if they don't have an instrument to donate, they can also just donate money.
- Mrs. Meyer requested a new trapezoid table (this is exactly like what she has in her classroom now) \$140 plus tax & shipping. Ally Getka made the motion. Seconded by Becky McKinney. Motion passed.

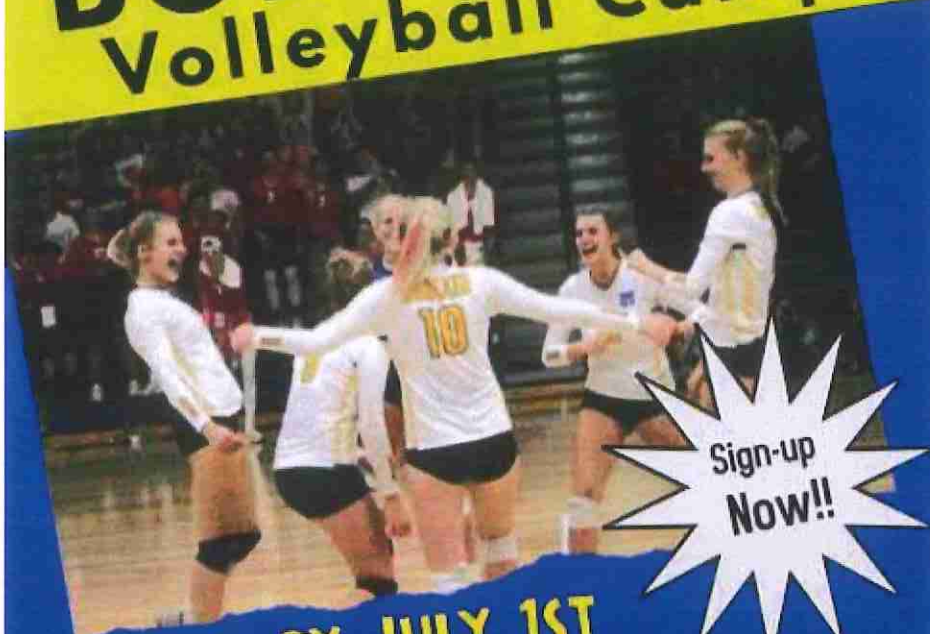

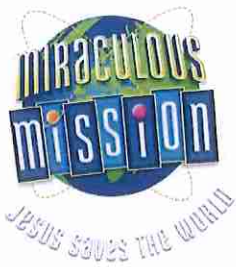

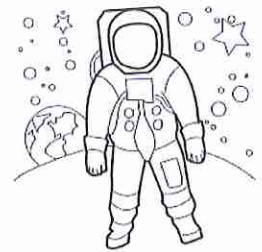
